The two Easter activities include:

## I. "Little Egg-credible Chefs"

Parents and children will participate in a dessert workshop led by Alberto Santos, head chef of Tapas de Portugal, where they will create their own delicious and sophisticated Easter chocolate eggs with Portuguese cream cheese filling. This collaborative workshop offers parents a wonderful opportunity to bond with their children and unleash the family's creativity while making lasting memories.

Each family will receive an egg hunting kit before embarking on a journey to complete missions and search for eggs at different checkpoints throughout Taipa Village. Upon successful completion, each child will be rewarded with a complimentary gift as a token of appreciation.
